




#### THE PHILIPPINES - Ain Karim

Sr. Eliza Ndegwa, SSV leads six SSV Sisters ministering in Borongan City, Eastern Samar, Philippines. Ain Karim Children's Home, operated by the Sisters, provides short and long-term care for children in crisis, malnourished, neglected, abandoned, and special children with disabilities. The SSV Sisters bring food, clothing, and medicines and *The Smile of God* to families in the remote areas.

## KENYA - Magnificat House

**Sr. Mary Gitahi, SSV**, the Superior Sister of the SSV Mission in OI Moran, tells us the children and youth of Magnificat House are thriving in their care. Their mission home serves very poor children and young adults with mental and physical disabilities and those abandoned or abused. The Sisters operate a <u>free medical clinic</u>, open daily, to bring vital medical services to the tribal communities, providing emergency care, laboratory services, medicines, and follow-up home care.

Needs: Funding for purchasing medicine for the SSV Free Medical Clinic for 2026.



# **BRAZIL** -Projecto Vida

Our dear friend, Sr. Rubi Arellano, SSV, along with three SSV Sisters serve in the town of Jaiba located in the state of Minas Grais, Brazil. Their large mission is called "Projecto Vida" or "Life Project" is dedicated to helping at-risk children who are vulnerable to local drug trafficking and street culture. Daily they minister to over 250 children offering a variety of workshops and two meals per day. This mission helps these youths and school age children stay off the streets, recover from the violence they witness, and to imagine and work toward a good future.
